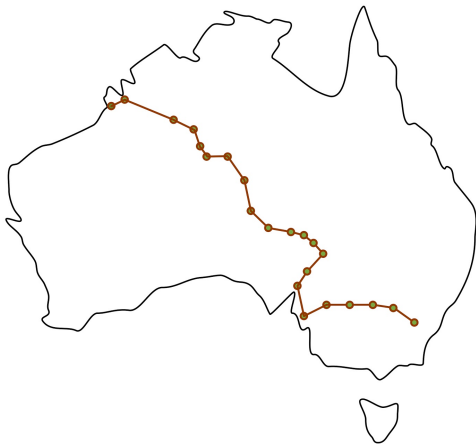

The road trip will commence on the **17th July 2017** departing from Canberra, Australia travelling through the cities and towns of Canberra, Wagga Wagga, Balranald, Mildura, Renmark, Adelaide, Port Augusta, Hawker, Leigh Creek, Nepabunna, Maree, William Creek, Oodnadatta, Coober Pedy, Marla, Alice Springs, Yuendumu, Tanami, Halls Creek, Fitzroy Crossing, Derby and Broome, Western Australia.
